





## GENERAL INFORMATION

**Train times** are indicative only and may vary by several minutes. Please check latest timetables or call National Rail Enquiries: 08457 484950

**No need to book.** Buy a day return ticket to the relevant station. For linear walks buy a ticket to the station that is furthest from your departure station.

**Request stops:** Stations at Chetnole, Yetminster, Thornford and Avoncliff are Request Stops. Please advise the conductor on the train that you wish to alight at a request stop. When joining at request stops, signal clearly to the driver to stop the train.

**Tickets:** Groups of three or four individuals can travel together for the price of two on Cheap Day Returns or Savers on Group Save tickets. A Day Ranger ticket may be more economical for a longer journey if you do not have a Seniors or other type of rail card.

**Please wear strong shoes/walking boots and bring waterproofs, drink and food.**

**Sorry NO DOGS can be allowed on the walks.**

Whilst every care will be taken to keep to the advertised programme, walks leaders reserve the right to make changes to suit weather conditions, the needs of the party or any other unforeseen circumstances.
